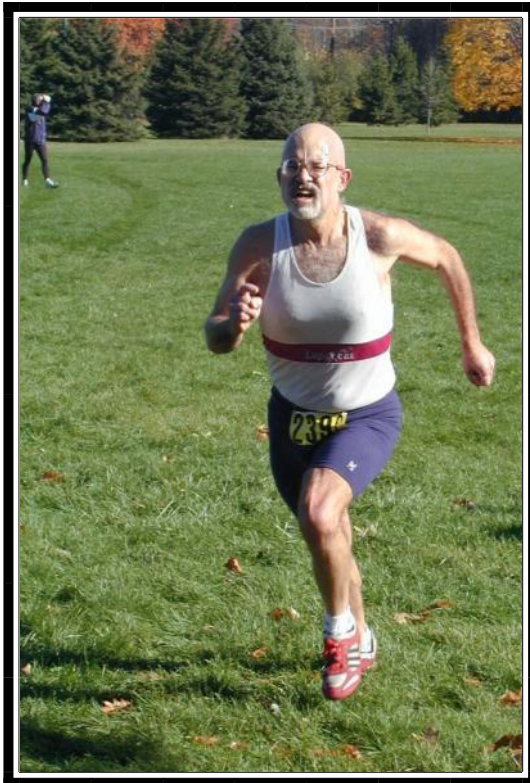

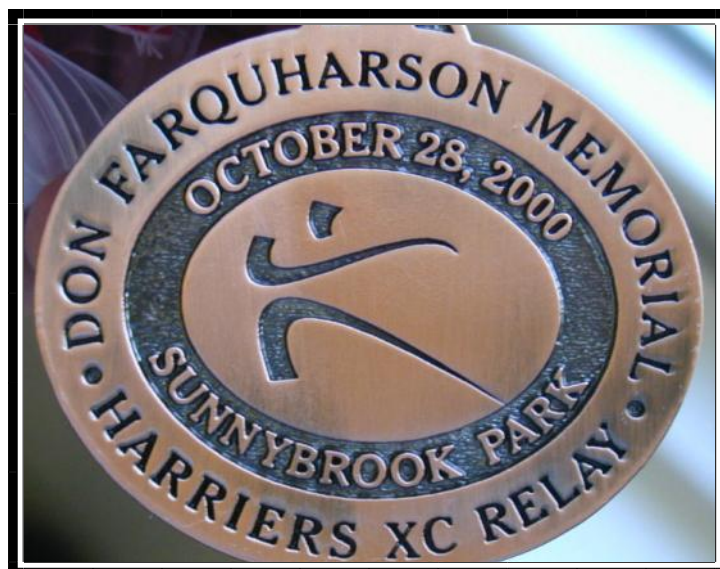

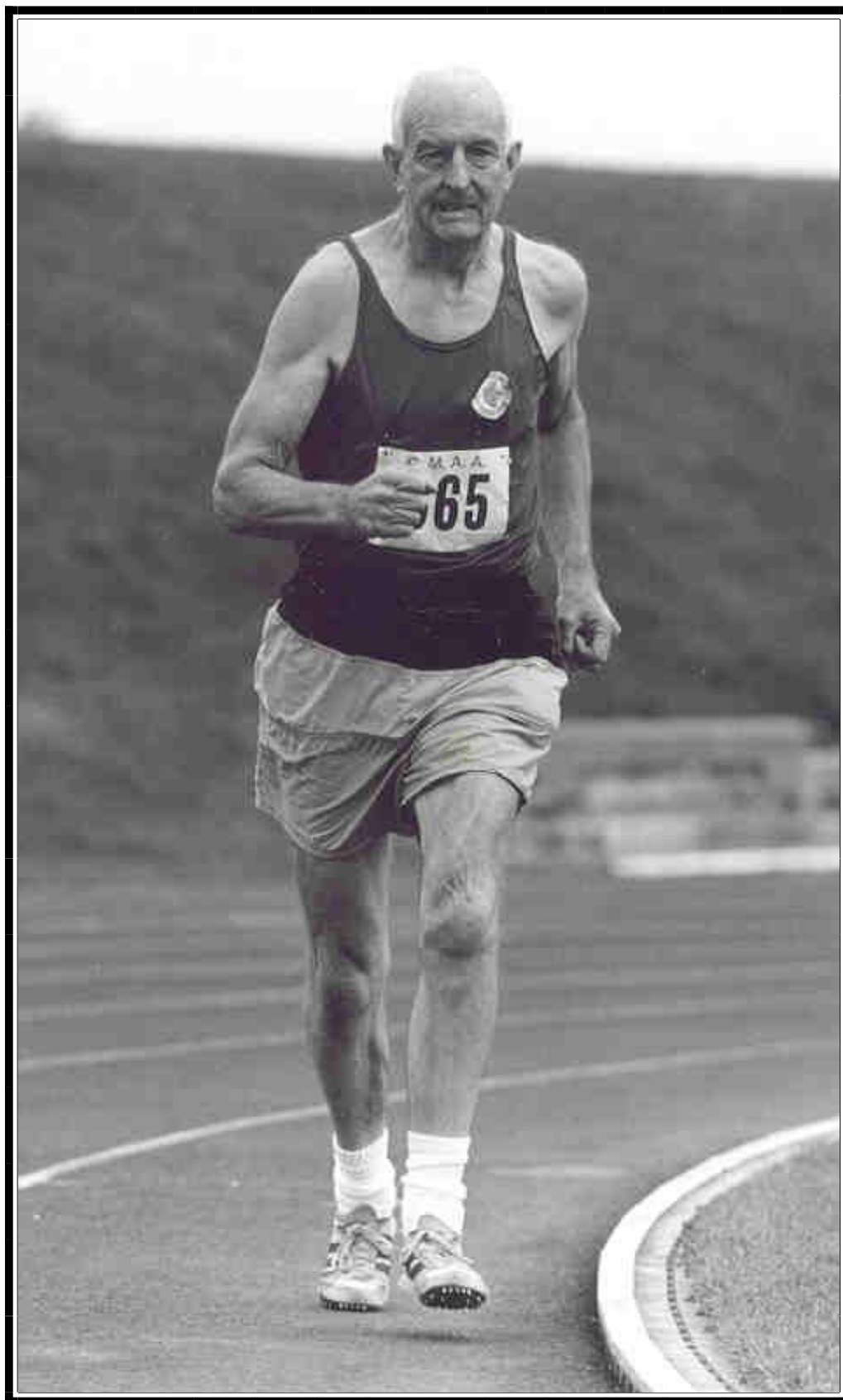

## DON FARQUHARSON MEMORIAL HARRIERS XC RELAY

October 28, 2000 was certainly a day to remember and in particular remember a man who was mainly responsible for not only the 'birth' of master's running in track & field, road and cross-country but for its universal acceptance world wide.

Don was especially fond of this relay event; in fact, you could say it had become his favourite over the years, so it seemed fitting to name the race in his memory. One hundred and three entries were received made up of twenty-nine teams (which included five teams of 'Farquharsons') of three runners each and sixteen individuals. *All those who entered actually ran which might well be a first!*

For the first time, medals were awarded to the first three male and female finishers on an age graded basis and each participant received a commemorative medal as they crossed the finish line.

The medal was designed by Brian Frank of Just Imagine Graphic Marketing Inc. and for those of you who did not hear the story, if you turn the medal on end and use just a little imagination, the stylized runner in the centre of the medal appears to be the initials "DF". Brian informed me that this was purely a coincidence and was not planned as part of the design.

They were Brooks for donating the majority of the prizes; Scarborough Masters for providing and serving the food and beverages (they do such a fine job, maybe they should consider opening a sandwich bar); Brian Keaveney and Jim Flowers for marking the course and assisting at both the start and finish lines and last but not least, the folk (I'm sorry, I can't remember all of your names) who assisted with registration, acted as marshals and prepared the results. A special thank you to Eileen Farquharson who came out to be our official starter and present some of the awards.

Next year, the race will take place on Saturday, October 27<sup>th</sup> and hopefully we will again be blessed with good weather. Please make a note on your calendars now or if you do not yet have one for 2001, make sure you mark the date down somewhere it will not be overlooked!
