

# EDITH GRAY SETS THREE WORLD RECORDS AT THE USATF INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

**A**lthough the Canadian contingent was small in numbers this year at the USATF Indoor Championships they made their presence felt by turning in some outstanding performances.

Three new world records were established by Edith Gray of Ontario in the W60 division. Her new marks were set in the high jump 1.26, pole vault 1.81 and the long jump 3.84 thus bettering the marks she set at the Ontario Indoor Championships earlier.

Earl Fee's continues to amaze although not setting any new world records his 400 metre, (61.78) 800 metre (2:18.66) and one mile (5:21.52) times were all 90%+ age graded performances.
