HOSTED BY COQUITLAM CHEETAHS

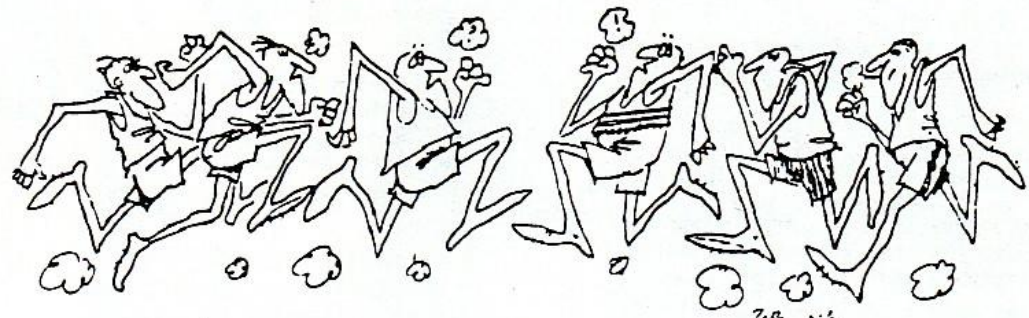
This event was the first section of the Pine Tree Classic, held in beautiful Mundy Park on wide, springy wood-chip trails, with a good variety of hills and sharp turns, over a two-lap 10 KM route. The weather was good to us, clear and fairly warm (about 10°), and while the entry was not large an atmosphere of camaraderie and good spirits prevailed as is usual when Masters get together. Following our exhausting endeavours to beat each other, or a previous time, we all made our way with spouses and friends to the Sheraton Villa Hotel in Burnaby, where we were hosted by Molson's in a fine spread of veggies, dip, cheese, crackers, fruit and BEER. Award ceremonies were presided over by Race Director, Shirley Smith, assisted by CMAA B.C. Branch President, Don Trethewey, Jean Cleator and Erna Kozak. Winners were awarded fine medals, while prizes of shoes, bags and t-shirts were donated by Brooks, who also provided numbers and Start/Finish Banners. We were delighted to have Frank Smith from Perth, Australia telephone one of our members on Friday and be invited to join the race - he came second. We were also pleased to see Arthur Taylor from Edmonton, running his first race this year, having been injured last winter. Art's taxi made a mistake and he arrived well after the race had started. Nothing daunted, Art and the starter went to the start line where he was correctly and officially started with the gun, approximately 10 minutes after the other racers. Art, running completely on his own, turned in a very excellent 37:42.6 to win his category (M55) and place 17th overall. A team of men from the Snohomish Track Club journeyed up to compete and shared a pleasant social gathering with us, and one of them won the race! We hope to see them again soon, and would like to see their Women Masters, too.
