I ran the half today and it didn't go so well. Came in around 1:12:20 or so. I'm in about 1:08 high or 1:09 low shape. Course or weather had nothing to do with it. Course was awesome...slight rolls and all along a valley right along the Danube. Finished through the industrial section of town which made me feel like I was back in St. Catherines. Weather was about 4 degrees and low wind so perfect again. The sun has even come out today for the first time since I have been here. I was in the lead pack for the first 10k and we split in 33 low and I was incredibly comfortable, but the wheels fell off the wagon about 13k and I just couldn't hold on. I'm sure the 3000m was still in my system and 3k and half is a tough double to train for.

Crowd support was great heading back into town ...cowbells, horns, people watching from overhead bridges.....that was very cool.

All in all, an amazing time and well worth it.

The 3000m was actually a real PB. I just started running again two years ago to lose weight. I had ballooned up to 250lbs after I quit running after university, so if you had told me that I would be bring home a silver from World Masters two years ago, I would have laughed and called you crazy.

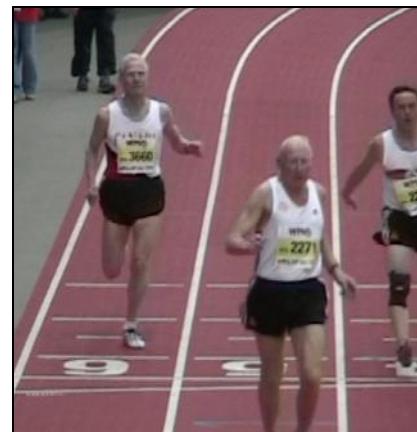
