**Richard Graves**, who passed away in February of this year, served for twenty years on the Executive of the Canadian Masters Athletics, the predecessor to the CMA, from 1985 to 2005. He served twelve years as the CMA Membership Secretary, during a period when computers were not used, and the process involved considerable manual work.

He also served for eight years as the Vice-President, Non-Stadia.

Richard competed in two WMA Championships, and in countless Canadian Masters Championships. He also competed in many Road Races, including running dozens of them as a means of raising large amounts of funds for a charity.
