

Canadian Masters Athletics 2019 Hall of Fame Athlete Inductees



Tom Dickson has been a CMA member for 25 years and is now aged 65. He has competed in six Canadian Masters Championships, winning every event he ran. He has broken 13 Canadian records – often besting his own year after year. He has been a finalist in his specialty, the 100m, in 9 World Masters Outdoor Championships and, in a total of 6 Championships, Indoor and Outdoor, he has won 7 medals. He has also competed with great success at WMA regional meets, World Masters Games, Huntsman World Senior Games and US Masters Championships. He has been undefeated in 19 BC Masters Athletics Championships in the 100m and 200m.

Tom has been honoured by BC Athletics as Masters Track Athlete or Masters Track and Field Athlete of the Year 10 times.

He gives back to the sport as an official, a coach (often serving as Team BC coach at National Junior and Senior championships and Summer Games) and as a clinician in the National Coaching Certification Program
