

## Marcel Jobin

Marcel Jobin had two Olympic appearances in the walks – in 1976 and 1984. (He was also selected for the boycotted 1980 Games). He was 42 in his second appearance. He was also a masters-age athlete in two of his four Pan Am Games, his World Championships, two World Cups and two Commonwealth Games. He set Masters age group records in 1981 and 1984 which still remain on the books.



Marcel returned to athletics some 26 years after his second Olympics. He has been a member of Canadian Masters for about 10 years. He is now 78 years of age. He competes in the walks – indoors and outdoors on the track and on the road. He has competed at 5 World Masters Championships, winning one gold, five silver and one bronze medals. His two NCCWMA Championships have yielded three gold medals and three meet records. He has competed in three Canadian Masters Championships, winning six gold medals.

Marcel holds 17 Canadian Masters records set between 1981 and 2018. He is a member of the Order of Canada and a Chevalier de l'Ordre National du Québec and was inducted into the Canadian Athletics Hall of Fame.
