

SUMMARY OF CMA DIRECTORS MEETING

July 20, 2021

1. Hosting 5K Road Racewalk Championships - A bid from “club d’athlétisme Corsaire-Chaparral” to host a CMA 5K Road Racewalk Championship, as part of the Demi-Marathon de Blainville on September 12, was reviewed and approved, including the provision of medals by the CMA without charge to the club.
2. Hosting Don Farquharson Memorial 4K Cross Country – A bid from Newmarket Huskies Track & Field Club to host the Don Farquharson Memorial 4K Cross Country Challenge on a date to be determined in September or October, 2021, was reviewed, including the provision of the medals without charge to the club.
3. Consideration of Withdrawal of Approval of Three Throws Records – A recommendation to withdraw the approval of three Throws records, which had been approved by the Board on June 22, was presented by Donna Dixon, Records Liaison, on the basis that the event at which they were set was not a duly sanctioned or authorized event, and there weren’t qualified officials present and officiating at the event. After presentations from Donna and Dan Parsons, a motion to withdraw the records was approved, moved and seconded by Donna and Jo Welch, with 8 votes in favour, 2 against and 3 abstaining.
4. Guidance on WMA Rules – An additional motion was made that Vern Christensen and Wendy Melvin follow up with Brian Keaveney for guidance on the application of WMA rules to CMA records. This motion was passed, with 9 votes in favour and 4 against.
