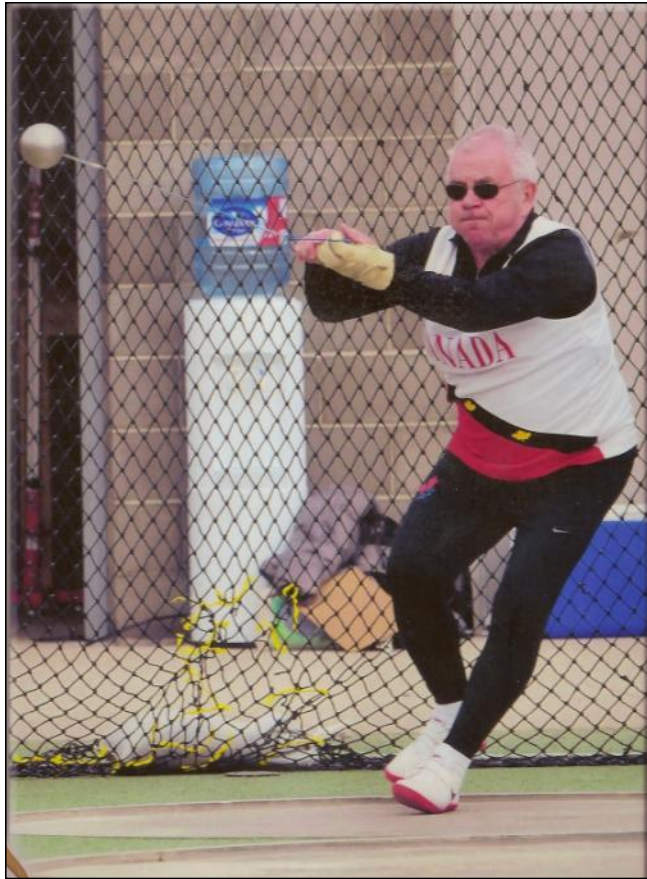


## Emil Muller



Although Emil Muller has only been a member of CMAA since 1990, by 2010 he had improved Canadian records in the hammer and weight 41 times! Now, as the newcomer in M75 his attack on the record book continues, with his best performances age-graded over 96%. Besides all those records, he has won eight medals at WMA and NCCWMA events, and many more at Canadian championships. Though born a Czech, Emil lived many years in Quebec, receiving recognition from the Federation d’Athletisme Quebecois in 2001 for his contributions as a fitness leader and coach. He has coached many young throwers, some to the national level, and served as the Quebec representative to the CMAA Board until his recent move to Ottawa. He is an ambassador for masters athletics, —starring in a Radio Canada feature on fitness for older adults due to be aired, en francais, this summer. In May 2010 he was nominated for the Order of the Czech Republic for his role as an ambassador of sport and goodwill. Not to be out-done by the Czech president, the CMAA wishes to honour Emil by induction into the Canadian Masters Athletics Hall of Fame.
