

## Marek Glowacki



When it comes to throwing things around the Field, Marek Glowacki throws them all: Shot, Discus, Javelin, Hammer and Weight, plus the Throws Pentathlon. He excels at the shot, with a 93.79% age-graded throw, but he's a champion and medal winner at WMA, NCCWMA, and Canadian championship meets in the discus and weight pentathlon as well. Internationally he has won a total of 27 medals in meets, indoors and out, from Sindelfingen to San Sebastian, Edmonton and Kamloops. In his native Poland, he was named Best Athlete of the Polish Veterans Championships in 2011. Other awards include CMA Male Field Athlete of the Year in 2011, and Alberta Male Master Athlete of the Year in 1996 and 2000. As for records, 8 of the 22 Canadian records he has set since he began competing in 1990 are still standing. He also holds 26 Alberta and 9 BC provincial records. Given that he is a graduate in coaching from the Warsaw Academy of Physical Education, it is not surprising that he is self coached. Since emigrating to Canada in 1981, he has been sharing his coaching expertise at schools and the University of Alberta, as well as with many Alberta Masters athletes on an individual base. In his spare time he was Athletics Alberta Technical manager, and developed the Provincial Masters Meets Programs.

For his many accomplishments and contributions we congratulate Marek, and welcome him into the Canadian Masters Athletics Hall of Fame.
